Regarding the expressions "solicited" and "unsolicited". Firstly, try to get "the dictionary habit" and look up unfamiliar words by habit. "Solicited" material means the publication asked you to write it for them. That is, they solicited it from you. Unsolicited means you sent something to the publication without them either asking you for it, or pre-agreeing to look at it such as in a phone inquiry.
